As a school we are transitioning into using the Daymap program, initially just for recording student attendance. Any student who arrives after 9:00 a.m. must be signed in at the front office where their arrival will be added to the Daymap system. Also if parents are collecting their child early, again they must be signed out via the front office. Eventually Daymap will be used to record all student data and for communication within the school staff but we will not be using it for parent contact at any time in the near future. Daymap will allow us to send group SMS messages in emergencies such as Bushfires – we are just getting this system set up now and hopefully a test message will be sent in the near future.

CAMPS

Over the next two weeks our Year 3, 4 and 5 students head off on camps. Our Year 3 and 4's are off to Arbury Park at Bridgewater next week. Arbury Park is a Department for Education run camp focussing on Environmental Education and is set in beautiful bush settings. Our Year 5 students are off to Illawonga at Swan Reach where they will have the opportunity to knee board, water ski, canoe, drive small boats, go caving and practice their gymnastics skills at a former Olympic Gymnastics training venue. I wish all the students a great time as they experience many different learning opportunities. Thank you to the staff who are giving up their time to organise and attend the camps and make them happen for our students.
